

Public Examinations during Adverse Weather Conditions.

Public examinations, such as AS, A2 or GCSE examinations, will not be postponed in the event of a school or college closure due to adverse weather. The School and College will be open for examinations even if it is closed to most students. Students will need to make every effort to arrive on time for an examination. The exams boards do not accept adverse weather conditions as a reason for submitting a "Special Consideration" for individual candidates unless the examination is the last available opportunity for assessment. Any coursework deadlines set by the board must also still be met.
